An Act relative to exemptions from MBTA community designations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 3A of chapter 40A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (a) by adding at the end thereof the following:
- 3           No community without a rail, subway, or ferry station shall have to comply with this  
4   section.
