### AN ACT RELATIVE TO TOWING STORAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 25 of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the first paragraph, the following paragraph:-
- 3 Said person(s) shall notify the lien holder of record as listed in the Massachusetts Registry of
- 4 Motor Vehicle records that he/she is in possession of said motor vehicle. Said notification shall
- 5 be sent via certified mail no later than 15 days from the date possession of the vehicle is obtained
- and shall state the name of the vehicle owner, the date possession was obtained, the make and
- 7 model of the vehicle and an itemization of the storage charges and any other duly authorized
- 8 work performed on the vehicle. If notification is not provided as indicated in this paragraph then
- 9 any lien shall not exceed the total sum of 15 days of storage charges and any other work
- 10 performed as listed in the notification.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 26 of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- Edition, is hereby amended by deleting in line 6 the word "twenty-five", and inserting in line 7,
- 13 after "within ten days", the following text:-
- or in the case of a lien described in section twenty-five within twenty one days of the date of the
- 15 letter notifying the lien holder as referenced in section twenty-five,
- SECTION 3. Section 26 of chapter 255 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 17 Edition, is hereby amended by adding, at the end of the section, the following sentence:-
- As part of said civil action if notification is not provided to the lien holder as provided for in
- section twenty-five and this section then any lien described in section twenty-five shall not
- 20 exceed the total sum of 15 days of storage charges and any other work performed as listed in the
- 21 notifications required by those sections.
