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An Act authorizing certain public employees' creditable retirement service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 378, the words "Peace Corps" and  
3 inserting in the place thereof the words:- Peace Corps, Vista or AmeriCorps

4           SECTION 2. Section 4 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 380, after the words "guidance  
6 counselor" the following words:- state employee
