In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to pension reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as

2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out clause (vi).

3 SECTION 2. Subdivision (2) of section 5 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby 4 amended by striking out paragraph (a) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

(a) The normal yearly amount of the retirement allowance for any member classified in
Group 1, Group 2 or Group 4, who has paid the full amount of regular deductions on the total
amount of regular compensation, including deductions specified in subdivision (3A) of section 3,
and in paragraph (d) of subdivision (1) of section 22, shall, subject to the limitations set forth in
this section, be based on the average annual rate of regular compensation received by such

10member during his years of creditable service or on the average annual rate of regular11compensation received by such member during the period or periods, preceding retirement, and12shall be computed according to the following table based on the age of such member and his13number of years and full months of creditable service at the time of his retirement.14Per Cent.Group 1.Group 2.14Group 4.
