An  $\operatorname{Act}$  directing the  $\operatorname{State}$  Board of Retirement to grant certain retirement benefits .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary and for the purpose of
- 2 promoting the public good, the state board of retirement shall pay Virginia Wise, the surviving spouse of
- 3 Raymond Wise, an officer of the Bridgewater State College police department retirement benefits as
- 4 provided under section 94 of chapter 32 of the General laws.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of June 29, 2004.
