Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 123 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 18 by striking out the last sentence of said section and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following new sentence: -
- 4 All hearings for commitments pursuant to this chapter shall be held at the courthouse,
- 5 unless a petitioner files a motion requesting that such hearing be held at the facility or said
- 6 hospital and shows good cause for such request.
