*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

2	SECTION 1. Section 21 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
3	Official Edition, is amended in line 4 by inserting after the word "limits", the following:
4	, provided that, notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a city or town
5	may not make any rule, regulation, ordinance or by-law interfering with interstate or intrastate
6	trade or commerce or regulating any product or consumer good, and provided further, that no
7	language in this section shall restrict the authority of any city or town from filing a home rule
8	petition under Article LXXXIX of the Articles of Amendment to the Constitution of the
9	Commonwealth.
