**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act to prohibit powdered alcohol.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 138 Section 1 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following at the end of the section:--

3 “Powdered Alcohol” Any powder or crystalline substance containing alcohol as defined
4 in this section produced for human consumption.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 138 Section 2 of the General laws, as appearing in 2012 Edition, is
6 hereby amended by adding the following section:--

7 Section 2A. No person shall sell, offer for sale, or deliver, receive or purchase for resale
8 in this Commonwealth, any product consisting of or containing powdered alcohol
