An Act relative to pay parity for county correctional officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the first-year  
2 base salary of a correctional officer employed by a sheriff’s department shall be equal to not less  
3 than the first-year base salary of a correctional officer employed by the Massachusetts  
4 Department of Correction.
