An Act relative to certain nonprofit employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 32 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second appearance of the word  
3 “authority” in line 16 the following:–“any employee of a nonprofit organization currently  
4 contracting with the commonwealth to provide goods or services that receives approval by the  
5 governing board of said organization and designated as a nonprofit under the United States  
6 Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) that consists of not more than 200 full-time employees,  
7 that receives 50 per cent or more of its annual funding from the commonwealth’s general fund  
8 and has received said percentage for at a minimum the most recent 4 fiscal years”
