## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to change the corporate and housing tax credits, tax incentives, tiff.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	The economic benefits of corporate tax credits do not trickle down to the citizens of our
2	Commonwealth nearly as much as the corporations that receive them. Massachusetts is in need
3	of a body that will research and assess the effectiveness corporate tax credits have on promoting
4	economic growth in order to ensure that these credits effectively promote job creation and
5	economic development in a fiscally efficient manner. To this end, I propose that these tax credit,
6	tax incentive, tiff"s ect be renamed "Corporate Welfare" to more accurately reflect their effects
7	and raise proper awareness of the state of corporate tax credit evaluation in Massachusetts.
