## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to health insurance for early education and care providers and their employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 2 of chapter 32A as most recently amended by chapter 130
- 2 of the acts of 2008 is hereby amended after the words “of Suffolk county”, by inserting the
- 3 following:- persons who are employed by early education and care providers that deliver early
- 4 education and care services under contracts with the department of early education and care.
