Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 sentence:- "Food products" does not include limited nutritional items sold in all retail stores.

- 6 Section 6A. Under the provisions of this chapter, a sales tax shall be imposed on the sale in any
- 7 retail store of any food product that has limited nutritional value.
