An Act relative to the fifth member of the public employee retirement systems.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 20 of sub-section (4) (b) of Chapter 32 is hereby amended by
2 deleting the third sentence in lines 205-209 of the 2014 Official Edition and inserting the
3 following: "If the fifth member is not chosen by the other four members within forty-five days
4 after the expiration or resignation of the term of the fifth member, said member shall be
5 appointed by the Public Employee Retire Administration Commission from a list of three names
6 , submitted by the remaining four members of the board; of individuals ready and willing to
7 serve, and the commission shall appoint the fifth member from such list.
