Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Subsection (2A) of section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws as
- 2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out in line 187, the word
- 3 "nine" and inserting in place thereof the word "eleven".
- 4 SECTION 2. Subsection (2A) of section 23 of chapter 32 as so appearing is hereby
- 5 amended by inserting after the word "Governor", in line 203 the following words:-
- 6 "two elected by members of the Executive Board of the Massachusetts Association of
- 7 Contributory Retirement Systems: from systems that have funds in the PRIT Fund; one from a
- 8 regional or county board, and one from a municipal retirement board."
