Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5A of Chapter 62 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by

- 5 of the United States Armed Forces will be exempt from paying Massachusetts state income tax
