An Act relative to Chapter 70 appropriations .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is

2 hereby amended by inserting, after section 12B, the following section:-

- 3 Section 12C. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, and in
- 4 accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, 8% of each fiscal year's total
- 5 appropriation shall be reserved for School Funds and State Aid for Public Schools, as described

6 in Chapter 70.
