### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act reducing the income tax rate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official
- 2 edition, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (b) in its entirety and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following subsection:-
- 4 (b) Part B taxable income shall be taxed at the rate of 5.15 percent for the taxable year beginning
- 5 January 1, 2012.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 4 of said chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 7 amended by striking out subsection (b) in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following
- 8 subsection:-

- 9 (b) Part B taxable income shall be taxed at the rate of 5 percent for the taxable year beginning
- 10 January 1, 2013.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act shall be effective only for the taxable year beginning January
- 12 1, 2012
- 13 SECTION 4. Section 2 of this act shall be effective for taxable years beginning on or after
- 14 January 1, 2013.
