An Act in aid of libraries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 64H of the general laws shall be amended by adding the following
2 paragraph:
3 (yy) used books and other items sold by libraries and library friends groups for the
4 purposes of raising money to be used for library purposes.
