In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act supporting residents and communities in resolving tax debt.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. The fourth sentence of section 62A of chapter 60 of the General Laws, a	1S

2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "25 per

3 cent", and inserting in place thereof the following words:- no more than 25 per cent or such

4 lesser percentage as the ordinance or bylaw may specify.

5 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall go into effect upon its passage.
