**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act ensuring consistent reimbursement of PILOT funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 58 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "section", in line 5, the following
3 words:-; provided, however, that if the measurable acreage of land pursuant to section 13 in the
4 city or town has remained the same or increased from the previous fiscal year, the total amount
5 reimbursed to a city or town by the commonwealth pursuant to section 17 shall not be less than
6 the amount that was reimbursed to the city or town in the previous fiscal year.

7 SECTION 2. Section 17 of chapter 58 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
8 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "sixty-three", in line 7, the
9 following words:- ; provided, however, that if the measurable acreage of land pursuant to section
10 13 in the city or town has remained the same or increased from the previous fiscal year, the total

11 amount reimbursed to a city or town by the commonwealth shall not be less than the amount that
12 was reimbursed to the city or town in the previous fiscal year.

13 SECTION 3. Section 108 of chapter 218 of the acts of 2016 is hereby amended by
14 striking out section 16 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

15 Section 16. The commissioner shall annually deliver, to the state treasurer, a statement of
16 the fair cash valuation reimbursement percentage for each city and town in which state-owned
17 land is located, and of the amount of money to be paid to each such city and town as determined
18 by the following section; provided, however, that if the measurable acreage of state-owned land
19 in the city or town has remained the same or increased from the previous fiscal year, the total
20 amount reimbursed to a city or town by the commonwealth pursuant to said section shall not be
21 less than the amount that was reimbursed to the city or town in the previous fiscal year.

22 SECTION 4. Said section 108 of said chapter 218 of the acts of 2016, is hereby further
23 amended by striking out, in section 17, the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
24 following sentence:- The treasurer shall annually reimburse each city and town in which state-
25 owned land is located, an amount in lieu of taxes upon the reimbursement percentages reported
26 to the treasurer by the commissioner under the preceding section, determined by multiplying the
27 percentages by the amount appropriated for such purposes for the fiscal year; provided, however,
28 that if the measurable acreage of state-owned land in the city or town has remained the same or
29 increased from the previous fiscal year, the total amount reimbursed to a city or town by the
30 commonwealth shall not be less than the amount that was reimbursed to the city or town in the
31 previous fiscal year.
