- 3 striking out, at the end of clause (3), the word "and".
- 4 SECTION 2. Said paragraph (p) of said section 6 of said chapter 64H, as so appearing, is
- 5 hereby further amended by adding at the end the following clause:-; and (5) sales of all living
- 6 trees used in commercial and residential landscapes.
