## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act to impose a tax on cigarette rolling papers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following section.
- 3 Section 2B. In addition to the foregoing tax there is hereby established an additional tax
- 4 of \$5 on the sale of tobacco rolling papers per package.
