## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act studying the special education circuit breaker reimbursement program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding Massachusetts General Laws the Treasurer of the Commonwealth shall conduct
- 2 a study to determine how lottery revenues or other revenue sources can be used to bring the
- 3 Special Education Circuit Breaker program up to full funding levels.
  
- 4 The Treasurer shall report back the findings to the Executive Office of Administration and
- 5 Finance and the House and Senate Ways and Means Committee within 180 days of the passage
- 6 of the bill.
