AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISIONAL EMPLOYEES IN THE LABOR SERVICE PERMANENT  
EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section  
2 28 the following:—  
3 Section 28A. All employees employed by the Commonwealth and by cities, towns, and districts, in the  
4 Commonwealth in a labor service position for two years or more shall be made permanent employees.  
5 The Personnel Administration shall annually report to the General Court the number of labor service  
6 employees made permanent.
