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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act relative to privately owned public use airport real estate taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the following clause:

3 “Fifty-eighth. With respect to property owned by a privately owned/public use airport  
4 that is used for aviation, that portion of which is used for taking off, landing and taxiing but not  
5 the portion from which non-aviation income is derived.”
