### AN ACT RELATIVE TO NATIONAL GUARD BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws of the 2004 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding  
2 the following sentence:-  
3 “Any member of the National Guard that has served a minimum of twenty years shall be eligible for state pension  
4 benefits regardless of the type of service performed.”
