In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to land conservation incentives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 38AA of chapter 63 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 88, the figure "\$2,000,000" and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following figure:- "\$10,000,000".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding, in
- 5 line 817, after the words "as amended" the following words:- ", or a nonprofit trust in realty
- 6 organized for the purposes of land conservation established pursuant to chapter 203."
- 7 SECTION 3. Said section 6 of chapter 62, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 8 striking out, in line 883, the figure "\$2,000,000" and inserting in place thereof the following
- 9 figure:- "\$10,000,000".

SECTION 4. This act shall expire on December 31, 2027.
