*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (l) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "persons;"
- 3 in line 182, the words "sales of personal safety devices and personal safety call services;"
