In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the senior citizen circuit breaker.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as most

2 recently amended by chapter 287 of the acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by inserting

3 after the word "commissioner.", in line 389, the following sentence:-

The real estate tax payment to be considered for purposes of calculating this credit shall also include 25 percent of the owner's home heating oil, natural gas, or propane, actually paid in the taxable year for which the credit is sought.

SECTION 2. Subsection (k) of said section 6 of said chapter 62 of the General Laws, is
hereby further amended by inserting after the word "thereof.", in line 393, the following
sentence:-

10 The rent constituting real estate tax payment to be considered for purposes of calculating 11 this credit shall also include 25 percent of the owner's home heating oil, natural gas, or propane, 12 actually paid in the taxable year for which the credit is sought.
