An Act reimbursing cities and towns for certain expenditures on behalf of veterans..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 Cities and towns that provide single room occupancy to veterans shall be reimbursed 100
- 4 per cent of the amount expended in the manner as provided above.
