An Act designating the month of October as adopt a shelter dog month.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section
2 15TTTTT, the following section:

3 Section 15UUUUU. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
4 month of October as Adopt a Shelter Dog Month, to increase public awareness and encourage
5 the adoption of shelter and rescue dogs in Massachusetts, and recommend that the day be
6 observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
