An Act relative to cueing and supervision in the PCA program.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1: Section 12 of chapter one hundred and eighteen E as so appearing, is hereby amended
- 2 in the first paragraph by inserting at the end thereof the following new sentence:-
- 3 “Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the division shall
- 4 develop or amend any standards and regulations applicable to the personal care attendant
- 5 program to include as eligible members those individuals who are otherwise eligible for said
- 6 program, but who require supervision and cueing in order to perform two or more activities of
- 7 daily living.”
