By Mr. Speliotis of Danvers, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2704) of Stanley and others relative to the solicitation of charitable donations for profit Joint Committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act Relative To For-Profit Charitable Solicitation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 68 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after Section 23 the following

2 Section:

3 Section 23(a):

4 Any Person, Professional Fundraising Counsel, Professional Solicitor, or any party who  
5 solicits charitable donations for profit in any way, as defined in Section 18 of Chapter 68 of The  
6 General Laws, must comply with the guidelines of this Section if the final amount of money that  
7 the charity that they have contracted with receives is less than or equal to 40% of their total  
8 donations:

9 1. All for profit solicitors as defined by Section 18 of Chapter 68 of The General Laws shall keep  
10 recordings of all calls made or letters sent for the purpose of soliciting funds pursuant to Section  
11 18. The recordings of the phone calls shall be kept on file with the company for a period of not

12 less than 180 days. At any point during this 180 day period these recordings shall be subject to  
13 audit and inspection by the Attorney General's Office. Furthermore, all solicitors working  
14 pursuant to Chapter 68 of The General Laws shall be subject to civil liability pursuant to Chapter  
15 93(A) of the General Laws for any violation of this Section.

16 2. Any solicitor certified under this Section 18 MUST state to any potential donor, either  
17 verbally or in writing, that they are "SOLICITING MONEY for Profit" and that they are "NOT  
18 AN EMPLOYEE of said Charity" or in any way a member of the charity for which they solicit  
19 funds. All solicitors working pursuant to Chapter 68 of The General Laws shall be subject to  
20 Civil Liability Pursuant to Chapter 93(A) of the General Laws for any violation of this Section

21 3. Any solicitor certified under this Section 18 who represents themselves, either verbally or in  
22 writing, to be a police officer, fireman, teacher, doctor, nurse, emergency medical technician,  
23 clergy member, or any member of a charitable organization for which they have contracted with  
24 shall be subject to civil penalties pursuant to 93(A), criminal prosecution pursuant to Section 23  
25 of Chapter 268 of The General Laws, or both.
