An Act relative to bundled cellular telephone transactions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting the following new section:  
3  (x) Allowances afforded to a purchaser in a bundled cellular telephone transaction, so-  
4 called. For the purposes of this subsection, allowances exempt from taxation shall be the  
5 difference between the amount the dealer charges for a particular telephone in a bundled  
6 transaction and the price the dealer would charge for that same telephone in an unbundled  
7 transaction.
