An Act relative to clarity in census disclosure.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Section 4 of chapter 51 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2008 Official

2 Edition is hereby amended by striking subsection c.

3 SECTION 2: Said section 4 is further amended by inserting the following subsection:-

4 "(f) The communication described in this section shall not include any reference to an

5 individual's right to vote or to political party registration or to the Commonwealth's Voter

6 Registration Information System (VRIS). The communication shall notify residents that the

7 information, excluding Veterans status, shall be part of the public record and that persons

8 meeting conditions described in subsections d and e of this section can remove their information

9 from that record, and shall provide the contact information to do so."
