**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act to improve child safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 97D of Chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following sentence prior to the last sentence now
3 existing in the section:

4 “Provided further, that nothing in this section shall be construed as to prevent law
5 enforcement officers from making any such reports or communication accessible to investigators
6 employed by the Department of Children and Families.”
