Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 29 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016 official edition is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after section 71 the following section:-

4 Section 72. State funds shall not be used to purchase single-use plastic bottles containing

- 5 64 ounces or less of non-carbonated water for use in facilities that are served by public water
- 6 supplies or potable well water, except when required for safety, health, or emergency situations.
