#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to providing the next of kin of a state police officer killed in the line of duty with a flag during the memorial service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 89 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- If an officer of the department of state police is killed, or dies from injuries received or
- 4 dies as a natural and proximate result of undergoing a hazard peculiar to the officer's
- 5 employment, while in the performance of the officer's duty, the officer's next of kin shall receive
- 6 from the department a flag of the commonwealth during the memorial service. For purposes of
- 7 this paragraph, next of kin shall mean a person who is a surviving spouse, partner, parent or close
- 8 family member of the deceased.
