- 1           Section 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 in the official 2016 edition is hereby amended in
- 2           subparagraph (g), under "Section 2" by inserting therein the words, "Forensic Scientists
- 3           employed at the Massachusetts State Police Crime Laboratory;" after the words, "head guard and
- 4           chief of waterfront police".
