## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act increasing penalties for operating vehicles under the influence.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 12-13, the words “, or is granted a  
3 continuance without a finding”.

4 SECTION 2. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by  
5 striking out, in line 23, the words “, or is granted a continuance without a finding”.

6 SECTION 3. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by  
7 striking out, in lines 167-168, the words “except for dispositions under section twenty-four D”.

8 SECTION 4. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby further amended by  
9 striking out, in line 753-754, the words “, or is granted a continuance without a finding”.
