Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 7 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:-
