An Act relative to small farm energy production.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2EEEE of chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting at the end thereof the following:- "provided, that not less than twenty-five percent of  
3 the funds deposited annually shall be transferred to the department of agricultural resources for a  
4 grant program in support of small farms under 750 acres in size to develop farm-based renewable  
5 energy capabilities, including wind harvesting, energy conserving refrigerated food storage pilot  
6 projects, methane capture and green combustion, and solar and photovoltaic energy projects to  
7 reduce energy costs for small farmers."
