**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act regulating certain activities at polling places.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 25B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as amended by section 13
2 of chapter 119 of the acts of 2015, is hereby further amended by adding the following
3 subsection:-

4 (r) Early voting locations shall be considered polling places for the purposes of section 65
5 and 950 CMR 54.04(22), and shall be subject to said section and said regulations.

6 SECTION 2. Section 65 of said chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
7 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

8 An early voting location shall be considered a polling place for purposes of this section.
