In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to nitrogen impaired embayments.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 21A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 For the purposes of this section, a watershed of a coastal estuary or embayment that is

4 included in the Massachusetts integrated list of waters, that is identified as impaired, due in

- 5 whole or in part to nitrogen pollution, shall be deemed to be a nitrogen sensitive area. The
- 6 department of environmental protection shall promulgate such rules and regulations as it
- 7 considers necessary to fulfill the requirements of this section.
