Beginning July 1, 2013, the department of public utilities shall permit each natural gas

2 company in the commonwealth to design and offer programs to consumers which increase the

- availability, affordability or feasibility of natural gas service for customers. Subject to the
- 4 department's approval prior to implementation, such programs may include alternative rate
- 5 structures to cover program costs including customer conversions costs, main extensions or other
- 6 costs for facilities necessary to add new customers through the program, cost-sharing, incentives
- 7 or other innovative means to accelerate the creation of jobs within the state and the realization of
- 8 benefits of the expansion of and conversion to efficient natural gas usage in the commonwealth.
- 9 The department shall review and approve proposed programs for each gas company on a cost-
- 10 effectiveness standard and on a schedule that enables timely customer access to available
- 11 programs. In the next general distribution rate proceeding, reasonable and prudent customer
- 12 costs and associated revenues added since the last general distribution rate proceeding shall be
- 13 included in the cost of service and such customers shall thereafter take service at the rate
- 14 approved by the Department in the general distribution rate proceeding.
