# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act to eliminate coal burning and use.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

SECTION 1. Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
is hereby amended by inserting after section 69I the following section:

3 Section  $69I^{1/2}$ 

4 Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter or any law to the contrary, no facility in 5 operation on and after January first, two thousand seventeen shall utilize or gasify coal.
