An Act to make provisional employees in the labor service permanent employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after Section
- 3 28 the following:—
- 4 Section 28A. All employees employed by the Commonwealth and by cities, towns, and districts,
- 5 in the
- 6 Commonwealth in a labor service position for two years or more shall be made permanent
