*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 21A1/2 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 6 the words “as a Certified
- 3 Massachusetts Assessor” and inserting in place thereof, “as a Massachusetts Accredited
- 4 Assessor,”.
