## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act allowing cable companies to compete for business on a statewide basis..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all cable
- 2 companies providing cable television service in the commonwealth shall be licensed by the
- 3 department of telecommunication and energy. Any such licensed company is free to market and
- 4 provide any and all of its products anywhere in the commonwealth.
